Vintage: 2023

Region: DO Montsant (Catalonia, Spain)

Grape Variety: 60% Red Grenache,
30% Carignan 10% Syrah

Harvest: Selected grapes from our own vineyards.

Elaboration: Carbonic maceration. This winemaking technique keeps the grapes whole and uncrushed whilst they ferment at high temperatures (30°C) in the absence of oxygen.

Alcohol content: 14,5% by vol.

Total SO₂: 27 mg/L

Total acidity: 4,6 g/L (tartaric acid)

Volatile acidity: 0,60 g/L (acetic acid)

Residual sugar: 1,4 g/L

Ph: 3,67
